**R. And let perpetual light shine upon them.**

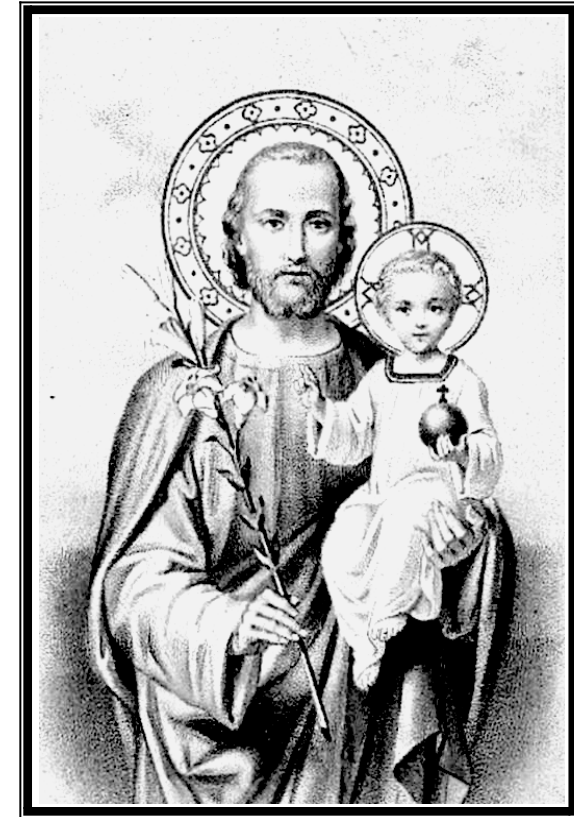
**V. May they rest in peace.**
